Walking Zone & Road Safety

Thank you to those parents that attended the Year 5 assembly on road safety and our new walking zone. The year 5 children have been working with Think Travel Gloucestershire to map out a 5 minute walking zone to encourage families to park and stride to school. The scheme aims to encourage people who have the necessity to drive, to drive part of the way and park and walk the remainder. The map leaflet was sent home with every pupil and shows the recommended grey areas for parking and the 5-minute orange walking zone. If you did not receive a leaflet, we have spare copies available at the main office.

With a reduction in parking facilities around the school and the summer weather, we hope that traffic can be dispersed and fewer cars used directly on the front doorstep of the school, helping to promote healthier lifestyles whilst improving road safety, and pollution levels.
