Dear Parent / Carer,

From time to time across our Trust of schools, it comes to our attention that parents may have had disputes on the playground or approached another person's child when they feel that the child has acted in an unkind way to their own child. As a Trust, we strongly feel that this type of behaviour is not acceptable and does not set a good example to the children. If parents have a concern or a complaint relating to any school matter, we would ask that you speak to a member of staff rather than taking matters into your own hands or posting information on social media sites. If the dispute between parents themselves relates to matters outside of school, we would ask that you do not address this publicly in the playground.

To try to ensure that the school environment is pleasant for everyone, the Trust board has drawn up a 'Code of Conduct' for all members of the school community. A copy of this has been sent home with all pupils and will be posted on our school website under the policies section.
